Oct. 20-25/ Day 1: Read Matthew 26:47-56; Mark 14:43-53': Jesus Arrested'

- Q. When are we tempted to take matters into our own hands out of 'devotion' to God?
- Q. How do you act in frightening situation? How can you stand firm when your faith is tested?

Oct. 20-25/ Day 2: Read Luke 22:47-53; John 18:1-11: 'Jesus Arrested'

- Q. What do you think about the last person Jesus' healed?
- Q. What principles for dealing with difficult and stressful circumstances do you see in Jesus's example?
- Q. How can you respond when you face stressful or difficult circumstances with 'no way out'?

Oct. 20-25/ Day 3: Read John 18:12-24: 'Jesus taken to Annas'

- Q. If Jesus was arrested today, to what religious authority might He be taken?
- Q. In our last few readings, we read of how the disciples scattered. Who went with Jesus & why (best guess)?

Oct. 20-25/ Day 4: Read Matthew 26:57-68; Mark 14:53-65: 'Jesus before the Sanhedrin'

- Q. What does Mark bring to this episode that differs from Matthew?
- Q. In what situation this week, do you need to tell the truth, even it may cost you?

Oct. 20-25/ Day 5: Read Matthew 26:69-75; Mark 14:66-72; John 18:25-27: 'Peter disowns Jesus'

- Q. What do the differences between each of these perspectives on Peter's denial indicate to you?
- Q. When have you denied Jesus, in word, thought, or practice?

Oct. 20-25/ Day 6: Study and Meditation – Consider the following questions:

- Q. Why do you imagine the less flattering elements of these stories have been included?
- Q. What has been your response to the thought that we are usually no better off?
- Q. What have you learned about yourself? About Jesus?
