Instructions

How to Complete

- Read each statement carefully and consider how it reflects your usual behavior.
- If a statement feels unclear, give it a lower score.
- Mark your answers honestly, focusing on your natural tendencies rather than learned behavior.
- For **Part One** scoring, you'll notice three is not an option, this is intentional. This keeps anyone who is on the fence about a particular answer to pick a side.
- For **Part Two** scoring, this one is a little more in depth with more questions, the difference being you can select the number three.
- There are scoring columns at the end of each Part. You can add your answers
 vertically and put the total in the corresponding box next to each letter. Doing the
 same for both Part One and Part Two. There is also a graph at the end to add a
 visual component.
