Warmup: If you had to choose a training soundtrack for your life right now, what song would it be?

READ Luke 4:14-21; Isaiah 55:11

- Why do you think Jesus chose His hometown synagogue for this announcement of His mission?
- How does Luke 4:18–19 reveal the heart of Jesus' mission? Which part resonates most with you personally?

REFLECT

- What is the promise contained in Isaiah 55:11?
- How have you experienced the truth of Isaiah 55:11 in your life or community?
- On a scale of I-I0, with 10 being "Chuck Norris, Texas Ranger-level ready," how prepared do you feel for a test of faith?
- What does "training in the Valley of Testing" look like in your life right now?

RESPONSE (In groups of 3 discuss the response questions)

- What "invisible prison" do you need to name and surrender to Jesus this week?
- Take a few minutes to identify an action step that will build spiritual muscle to keep you out of your invisible prison this week.
- Who in your life needs to hear your story of how Jesus has set you free? How will you share it?
- Share other ways you can put the Good News "in motion" this week.
