- Preach and participate regularly in Sunday worship, including assisting with sacraments.
- Provide pastoral care, in collaboration with the Lead Pastor and campus leadership.
- Recruit, equip, and mentor leaders and volunteers for ministry teams.
- Support the growth of ministries relevant to the local context (e.g., playgroup, youth, hospitality).
- Help coordinate worship gatherings and ministry programs with a high level of excellence and contextual awareness.
