The Sacred Essence

In his book *Sacred Earth Sacred Soul*, John Philip Newell writes:

As the birth of the Christ Child was acclaimed by angelic song, "...on earth peace, goodwill among people" (Luke 2:14), so the Christhood of every child, of every man and woman, was destined for the work of peace. To know the sacred essence of our being is to know also our calling to serve this sacredness in one another and in the relationships of our lives and world."

As we reflect on the creation story found in Genesis, we are reminded that God created humankind in God's image, breathing God's very spirit, the breath of life, into us. Recognizing the sacred essence in one another may be challenging in this age of polarizing division and conflict in our nation and world. There is a greeting from Hinduism with ancient Sanskrit roots: *namaste*. It carries the deeper meaning of recognizing the divine in each other, as the word *namaste* literally means "I bow to you."

Epiphany, meaning “revelation” or “manifestation,” is the winter season of light. Beginning with the visit of the Magi to the infant Jesus and stretching through weeks until the beginning of Lent, this is the time of stars, of waxing light, of illumination and enlightenment.

The Wise Men awaited a sign in the sky — a star — to guide them on this journey. Revelations break in, signs appear in dreams, light shines forth, and glory hovers all around. Such things are from the realms of miracle, awe, and wonder. They surprise and disrupt the normal course of existence. Epiphanies are not of our making.

We cannot create epiphanies, but, like the Wise Men, we can respond to them. Epiphanies grab a hold of us; we can't shake them. Epiphanies beckon. The star invites; it calls to the attentive to do something — to act.

Epiphany is a manifestation, the mystery revealed, and an invitation to discover grace, goodness, and God. It is neither a magic fix nor a moment when utopia arrives. The birth, the star, and heavenly glory don't eliminate the darkness. Rather, such revelations cast the light that we needed to see the way ahead. Epiphany beckons us to pay attention and participate in widening the circle of light in the world — to push back against all brittle injustice and brutality.

Epiphany moves from the story of kings following the light of a star to Jesus' words to his followers: You are the light of the world. Perhaps these words, a seasonal benediction of sorts, from *A Ring of Endless Light* by Madeleine L'Engle, capture the fullest sense of Epiphany:

*This is my charge to you.
You are to be a light bearer.
You are to choose light.*

Arise. Shine. Be light.
