7 Scriptural Rules

1. **James 4:10:** Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you.
2. **Isaiah 1:18:** “Come now, let us reason together, says the Lord: though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red like crimson, they shall become like wool.
3. **Psalms 34:8:** Oh, taste and see that the Lord is good! Blessed is the man who takes refuge in him!
4. **John 8:31-32:** So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed him, “If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.”
5. **John 20:31:** but these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.
6. **1 Peter 3:15:** but in your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect
7. **Acts 17:11:** Now these Jews were more noble than those in Thessalonica; they received the word with all eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily to see if these things were so.

Conclusion: TEST EVERYTHING

1 Thessalonians 5:21: but test everything; hold fast what is good.
