People love camping, and for good reason! You can take in nature, practice special skills, or just take time to relax in a new environment. And when it comes to camping, no one loved it as much as John the Baptist. In this 4-week series, VineKids will hear about John the Baptist's special role in preparing the way for Jesus and his ministry. John's story will help VineKids to say their camp motto, **"I believe God gives me purpose. I believe God can speak to me. I believe God is powerful. I believe God's words are true."**

To get ready for this teaching series, spend a few minutes each week **studying** the passages of Scripture we'll be teaching, **praying** about what God wants to do in and through us in the next few weeks, and **growing** by putting God's words into practice in your own life.

## WEEK 1 I believe God gives me purpose.

Mark 1:1–8; Ephesians 1:3–14

## WEEK 2 I believe God can speak to me.

Luke 3:2–3, 21–22; Psalm 29:3–9

This week, kids learn about how **John baptized Jesus** and how God spoke to Jesus.

- **BIG IDEA:** I believe God can speak to me.
- **BIBLE:** Luke 3:2–3, 21–22; Psalm 29:3–9

### REMEMBER THIS

This month, your VineKid(s) are memorizing the Bible verse **John 6:69 (NIV)**, in case you want to work on them

### ASK THIS

- What did the voice of God say to Jesus after he was baptized?
- What are some ways we can hear God's voice today?

## WEEK 3 I believe God is powerful.

Matthew 4:1–11; Psalm 36:5–10

This week, kids learn about how **Jesus is tempted** in the wilderness and used God's words to defend against the tempter.

- **BIG IDEA:** I believe God is powerful.
- **BIBLE:** Matthew 4:1–11; Psalm 36:5–10



### REMEMBER THIS

This month, your VineKid(s) are memorizing the Bible verse **John 6:69 (NIV)**, in case you want to work on them



### ASK THIS

- What did the devil use to tempt Jesus first? What did Jesus say?
- What are some temptations kids like you might face today? How can you trust God's power to overcome them?

## WEEK 4 I believe God's words are true.

Luke 4:14–30; Psalm 19:7–14



### THIS WEEK

This week, kids learn about how **Jesus was rejected** as God's Son in his own hometown.

- **BIG IDEA:** I believe God's words are true.
- **BIBLE:** Luke 4:14–30; Psalm 19:7–14



### REMEMBER THIS

This month, your VineKid(s) are memorizing the Bible verse **John 6:69 (NIV)**, in case you want to work on them



### ASK THIS

- What did the passage that Jesus read at the synagogue say?
- What can you do to learn more of God's words?
