## WRCC 2025 Food Pantry Details

Total incoming Food and Non-Food Pantry items—5782  
Most came in during May with 1209 of 1470 items from the Postal drive

Total Outgoing Food and Non-Food Pantry items—5967  
The most items went out to Pantry clients in April with 643 going out

Total number of Households served by our Food Pantry—78  
Three months had the most households served with 8 each month

Total number of Individuals served by the Food Pantry—220  
May had the most individuals served with 29 people from 8 households

WRCC members gave 1148 out of the 5782 total Food and Non-Food Pantry items that came into our Food Pantry in 2025—almost 20%.
