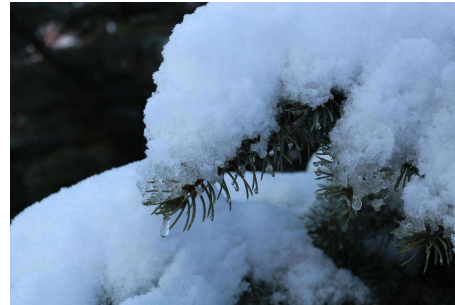

## A SEASON OF LIFE!

*"For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven: a time to be born, and a time to die; a time to plant, and a time to pluck up what is planted; a time to kill, and a time to heal; a time to break down, and a time to build up; a time to weep, and a time to laugh; a time to mourn, and a time to dance; a time to throw away stones, and a time to gather stones together; a time to embrace, and a time to refrain from embracing; a time to seek, and a time to lose; a time to keep, and a time to throw away; a time to tear, and a time to sew; a time to keep silence, and a time to speak; a time to love, and a time to hate; a time for war, and a time for peace. What gain have the workers from their toil? I have seen the business that God has given to everyone to be busy with." (Ecclesiastes 3:1-10)*

As one season transitions to the next, we witness an array of changes in our environment—ranging from the warmth of summer to the coolness of autumn, the chill of winter, and the renewal of spring. The characteristics of each season may vary depending on geographic location.

Similarly, life is marked by distinct stages, including infancy, adolescence, adulthood, and old age, each accompanied by its own set of transformations. 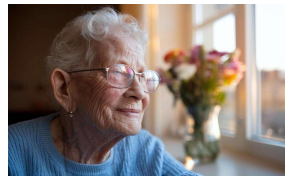
