- Session 5-The Old Testament Points to Jesus - Luke 1; John 1

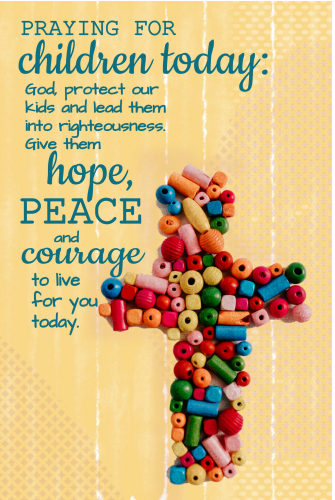
