## Practical Tools for Christian Families

### Key Truth:

Technology is a *tool*, not a substitute for teaching, trust, and accountability.

## Layer 1 — Protect the Whole Home (Internet Filtering)

### OpenDNS Family Shield (FREE)

Blocks adult websites on every device connected to your home Wi-Fi.

DNS Settings:

- **208.67.222.123**
- **208.67.220.123**

Benefits:

- Easy to set up
- No monthly cost
- Works on TVs, tablets, computers, and phones on Wi-Fi

## Layer 2 — Device Protection

Recommended Apps:

- Net Nanny - <https://www.netnanny.com>
- Qustodio - <https://www.qustodio.com>
- Bark - <https://www.bark.us>
- Norton Family - <https://us.norton.com/store>
- Canopy - <https://www.canopy.us>

These can:

- Block explicit sites
- Monitor searches
- Set screen limits
- Alert parents

## Layer 3 — Accountability

Technology alone is not enough.

Helpful practices:

- Devices used in common areas
- No overnight private internet use
- Spouses sharing passwords
- Accountability partners for teens & adults

## Layer 4 — Build a Culture of Openness

- Talk early and often
- Teach God's design for sexuality
- Emphasize grace & restoration, not shame
- Encourage confession without fear

### Goal:

Not just "blocking sin" but **training hearts and habits.**

# 2. Step-By-Step OpenDNS (Family Shield) Setup

## What You Need:

- Your Wi-Fi router login (usually printed on router)

## Step 1 — Log Into Your Router

1. Open browser
2. Type one of these:  
    192.168.1.1  
    192.168.0.1
3. Enter username/password

## Step 2 — Find DNS Settings

Look for:

- Internet Settings
- WAN
- DHCP
- DNS Server

## Step 3 — Enter These Numbers

Primary DNS:

**208.67.222.123**

Secondary DNS:

**208.67.220.123**

Save and reboot router.

## Step 4 — Test It

Try visiting a known adult site — it should be blocked.

## Advanced (Optional)

Create a free OpenDNS Home account to:

- Customize categories
- View reports
- Block additional sites

# 3. “Minimum Protection Kit” (By Skill Level)

## Beginner (Least Technical) \*\*\*

- Turn on Apple Screen Time / Google Family Link
- Use OpenDNS Family Shield
- Keep devices in public areas

**Cost: \$0**

## Intermediate (Most Families)

- OpenDNS or Router Filtering
- Qustodio or Bark on phones
- Accountability partner or parent reports

**Cost: ~\$5–15/month**

## Advanced / Strong Protection

- Router filtering + OpenDNS
- Device filtering software
- Accountability monitoring
- Remove private browsing access
- Disable app store installs without approval

**Cost: ~\$15–30/month**

### \*\*\* Notes:

#### Apple Screen Time & Content Restrictions (for iOS/Mac devices)

Built-in feature on iPhones, iPads, and Macs. Enable it in Settings >Screen Time to restrict adult websites, limit app usage & set passcodes. It's straightforward with no extra cost.

#### Microsoft Family Safety (for Windows & Xbox)

Free tool integrated into Windows accounts. Blocks adult content, sets time limits & monitors activity. Easy to enable via [family.microsoft.com](https://family.microsoft.com)

**Great for households with multiple Microsoft devices**

#### Google Family Link (for Android devices)

Free app from Google that lets parents set screen time limits, approve apps & block inappropriate websites including porn via SafeSearch & content filters. Works across phones, tablets & Chromebooks.

**Download from Google Play Store & follow the setup wizard**
