Packing List:

Optional

9. Bag for dirty clothes (helpful)

12. Money for Mission Offering (Thursday)

The Camper will not need:

1. Any electronic device (iPads, video games, tablets, or computers)
2. Secular Books
3. Tobacco/Alcohol/Drugs
4. E-cigarettes

The Camper will be expected to:

1. Bathe every day
2. Eat at every meal
3. Attend every service
4. Attend all in-cabin study times
5. Be on time
6. Not pull pranks - a bad experience can define and hurt the full week and longer
7. Take their turn on Kitchen Patrol (KP) to help with clean up
8. Give us their medication so we know when it was taken and by whom.
9. Take the group picture
10. Be courteous and respectful to everyone
