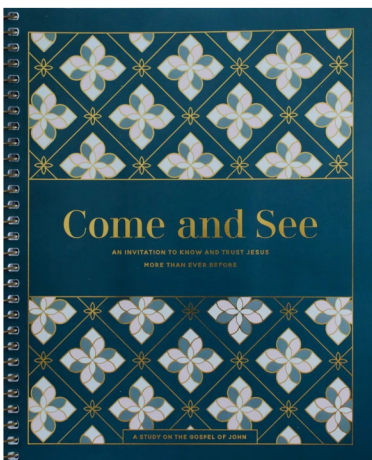
This week, our Prayer Focus is TO RECEIVE THE HOLY SPIRIT

### STUDY WITH SHARON THOMAS

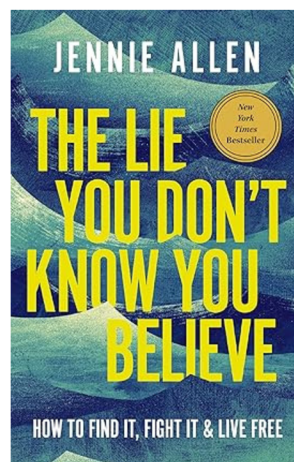
