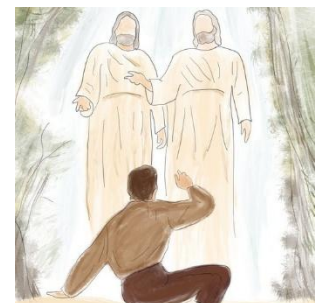

June Holidays!



Flag Day:

The American flag was adopted by the Second Continental Congress on June 14, 1777. It was officially made a national holiday when President Truman signed the Congressional Act in 1939.



Juneteenth:

Juneteenth is observed on June 19th to commemorate the emancipation of slaves by President Lincoln. It was made an official federal holiday when President Biden signed the Juneteenth National Independence Day Act in 2021.



Father's Day:

The concept originated in Spokane, Washington, in 1910, driven by Sonora Smart Dodd to honor her Civil War veteran father. It was officially signed into a permanent national holiday by President Richard Nixon in 1972.



First Day of Summer:

In the Northern Hemisphere, summer officially begins on Sunday, June 21, 2026, which is marked by the astronomical summer solstice. This day features the most hours of daylight for the year. By contrast, meteorological summer—which is used by climatologists and weather forecasters—begin on June 1.
