Jude: God Is Able (Jude 1:20-25)

Warmup: What's something you've tried to do on your own that turned out to be much harder than you expected?

READ Jude 1:20-25, Romans 8:26-27

- What are the action steps Jude writes to his beloved friends in verses 20-21?
- How do the action steps of verses 20-21 become “the equipping” for verses 22-23?
- As mentioned in the sermon, what struggles did Jude have in his faith?

REFLECT

- Which of the disciple action steps mentioned in verses 20-23 are the most difficult for you? Why are these difficult?
- Based on the sermon and verses 20-25, what is God saying to you concerning the challenges you mentioned above? What does He want you to firmly know and believe?
- Help Word Studies offers the Greek translation for *pray*: to exchange wishes; literally, to *interact with the Lord by switching human wishes (ideas) for His wishes*.
 - How does this definition work with your current practice of prayer?
 - Read Romans 8:26-27. What is God speaking to you, personally, in this Scripture?

RESPOND

- In what area of your life are you most vulnerable to stumbling?
- Which of the action steps Jude gives followers of Jesus in verses 20-23 are you tackling this week?
- Read verses 24-25 aloud at least twice. Listen for God's encouragement and record it as a lasting reminder of God's faithfulness to you.
