A heart for evangelism

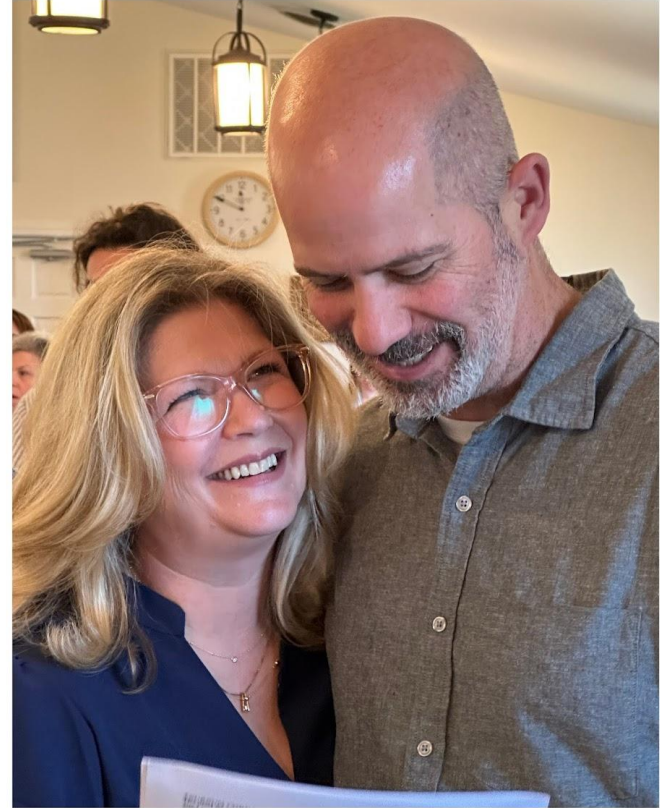
