Scripture: Luke 15:11-24

Lesson Aim: Identify the younger son's choices, the outcome of each choice, and respond as God would have us to.

Key Verse: The son said to him, Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. I am no longer worthy to be called your son. - - - Luke 15:21

Concepts:

Vv. 11-12

1. There are times when God will give us what we want even to our detriment.
2. We do not have to leave or stray, physically, from church, home, or community to be lost.

v. 13a

3. When we have sin in our hearts we are prone to wander away from God.

Vv. 13b-19

4. Sometimes we can only find ourselves when we are in uncomfortable places

Vv. 20-21

5. When we repent and confess our sins, God will completely wipe them away and give us a fresh start.

Vv. 22-24

6. Because God wants everyone to be part of His kingdom, He celebrates when we humble ourselves and return to Him.
