Warmup: What is the best lesson you learned as a young person?

READ Proverbs 1:1-19, Proverbs 13:20

- What major points in this chapter does Solomon want his readers to understand? This proverb is mainly for whom? This Proverb is also written for the benefit of others such as? (verses 4 - 5)
- According to this passage, what are the benefits of wisdom? How would you translate verse 9 into your common language?
- What is God saying to you in these verses?

REFLECT

- Now read Proverbs 13:20. How have you seen this truth played out in your life?
- As you read this chapter what do you wish you could have known as a young person? How could a mentor have helped you navigate your teens and twenties? Discuss how age impacts spiritual wisdom and confidence in God? Does verse 7 affect your answer in any way?
- How does what Jesus is teaching you in these verses line up with your life?

RESPOND

- How can you raise hope within your church and your community, specifically within the lives of young people? How could this investment in a young person become part of your transformation?
- Pray within a group of three to identify a young person to encourage in the way of Jesus. After your time in prayer discerning God's direction, record several names the Holy Spirit conveyed to you. Be accountable to your group of three to contact one of these teens or young adults this week.
- How is the Spirit leading you to respond this week?
