Every Sunday at 4:00 p.m. from October 15th through December 17th there will be a Choral Evensong, a Service of Readings & Music, or a Concert at the Cathedral.

On Wednesday, November 1st at 7 p.m. there will be a Festal Evensong to commemorate All Saints' Day with the three choirs of All Saints Cathedral and Capella Regalis Men & Boys & Girls Choirs.

On Sunday November 19th, Capella Regalis Men & Boys Choir, will sing for both the 11:00 a.m. Choral Eucharist and the 4:00 p.m. Evensong. At the afternoon service new boys will be formally invested into the choir.
