



Bishop Robert E. Farrow, D. Div, is the Presiding Bishop of the Northeast Free Will Baptist Conference (NEC). He was elected and consecrated bishop in 1999. He is committed to the synergistic fellowship of multiple churches in the tri-state area of PA, DE and MD.

Bishop Farrow was elected pastor of Mt. Calvary (FWB) Church & Ministries, Inc. (MCCM) Baltimore, MD in 1972. Adopting the theme "*A Church Determined to Reconcile a Broken Community*," (2 Cor. 5:18), his 52 years of pastoral ministry sought to launch a ministry destined to bring this goal to fruition.

An accomplished theologian and community leader, Bishop Farrow earned his BA. (1976) and MDiv. (1979) theology degrees from Virginia Seminary and College, Lynchburg, VA. He later was conferred honorary Doctor of Divinity and Humane Letters from same institution.

Bishop Farrow is the Chancellor, Maryland Theological Seminary (extension campus, Eastern Theological Seminary, Lynchburg, VA), also Dean, Old Testament Studies. He's an active member of the Ministers Conference of Baltimore and Vicinity; and serves as Sergeant at Arms.

Bishop Farrow, a native of Kinston, NC, enlisted in the U.S. Army after high school graduation. Trained as a paratrooper, he served a three-year tenure in the 82nd Airborne Division, Fort Bragg, NC. After his military tour, he moved to Baltimore, MD, enrolling in the Maryland Institute College of Art majoring in Interior Design.

His wife of 40 years, Elder Jacqueline (*Carrington*) Farrow shares with him in leadership at MCCM. They are blessed with four children and eight children.
