Description and Definition of Funds at Hope

- General Fund: General tithing fund. Used across many areas of the Church's work. Unless you have a specific desire for how your gift be used, we encourage you to donate to the General Fund.
- Debt Retirement Fund: Used to pay down the Church's mortgage on our 98 campus building to allow freedom of use of both the upstairs and downstairs.
- Building/Facilities Fund: Used for building maintenance and capital expenditures on our current church building and property.
- Church Plant: For establishment of new worship locations and/or new churches
- Disaster Relief: Provides funds for relief of disasters within the Southern District of the Church
- Worship: Used for expenditures relating to any facet of worship, including but not limited to tech, altar guild, flowers, etc.
- Outreach: used for the efforts made to communicate with individuals and families in our greater community who may or may not have heard of Hope or Jesus.
- Scholarship Fund: Funds raised go to area individuals pursuing higher education, Church also budgets for this scholarship yearly.
- Layettes: Supports the women's layette ministry, which provides clothing and garments for newborns at Sacred Heart whose parents need assistance
- Community Assistance: Provides care and assistance to people and organizations in the local area with the intent to support them and their life in Christ



- Human Care Ministry: Provides care and assistance to those in the Hope church family who may need it
- Women of Hope: Supports the Women of Hope and the charities and ministries they conduct
- Men of Hope: Supports the Men of Hope and the charities and ministries they conduct
- Children's Ministry: Used for items relating to children's church, the nursery, and Vacation Bible School.
- Youth Ministry: Used for items relating to Youth Group, confirmation classes, and youth gatherings and retreats
