Writing Style:	A collection of Oracles / Poetry
Background:	An expansion of the kingdom and prosperity (Uzziah/Jeroboam)
Themes:	Marriage / Sin / Hope. 'God's undying love for His people'
Characteristics:	Language relies on the covenant stipulations of blessings and curses.
