centering prayer

It is as if God My earth spea to you in the stillness of summer mornings.

My earth speaks

Press your ear upon the earth. Listen to my life. You are a prayer happening forever in my heart. You are my earth's keeper. We are in this together. Please, go deeper now into the listening, and remember.

Centering Prayer is a receptive method of Christian silent prayer which deepens our relationship with God, a prayer in which we can experience God's presence within us.

The method of Centering Prayer consists in learning to withdraw attention from our thoughts - those incessant creations of our busy minds - in order to rest in a gentle, open attentiveness to divine reality itself.

Centering Prayer familiarizes us with God's first language which is silence.

Guidelines for Centering Prayer

- 1. Choose a sacred word as the symbol of your intention to consent to God's presence and action within. Examples of a sacred word: Silence, Stillness, Faith, Trust, Holy, Glory, God, Jesus, Abba, Father, Mother, Amen, Love, Listen, Peace, Mercy, Let Go.
- Sitting comfortably and with eyes closed, settle briefly. Silently begin to repeat the sacred word, which points you gently towards God's presence. When you are ready, you can let go of the sacred word and simply rest in God.
- 3. When outside thoughts engage or distract you, return ever-so-gently to the sacred word and turn towards God's presence.
- 4. At the end of the prayer period, remain in silence with eyes closed.

Most Loving God:

Your grace and love are awakening us, turning us, softening us, and like a sunflower we respond in kind to the warmth of your light, life, and love.

Amen.
