We have been able to bring people to new life in Christ! Our friend "Andrew", received physical healing "In Jesus Mighty Name". He went from being on a kidney transplant list, (liver failure), to losing 80 pounds & complete healing in his liver/kidneys. Praise our Redeemer!

## This World Is Not Our Home

We have been praying for a new home to live in. At the end of August, we will move out our home, place a few belongings in storage, and take a much needed furlough. It has been over 10 years, since we have actively tried to fundraise, re-connect with all of our ministry partners, & rally people to pray for the nations. We have visited small pockets of ministry partners, here and there, but are in desperate need of more help. Over the past four years in Oahu, we have been operating with 50% of the needed financial support, to effectively preach the gospel, disciple new believers, & see local leadership trained, to lead local churches.

Every member of our family (children included,) have worked multiple jobs, to make ends meet & continue ministering together. This was the result, of moving to Oahu, in the middle of a very desperate time for churches, as they navigated the Covid season. We do not regret moving here in those circumstances. It allowed us to humble ourselves, work hard with our hands, lead people to Christ & disciple them.

## How to Effectively Pray, With Our Ohana

We have already prayed over, other hurting communities on Oahu, that need gospel preaching, & local churches. As we rally everyone during furlough, we will plan, prepare, equip ourselves, pray & glean wisdom, to effectively return to Oahu, greater equipped to preach the Gospel. As we transition from our current community, our brothers and sisters in Christ, will continue the ministry, whole-heartedly with the Holy Spirit & Jesus Christ. We have been missionaries for 17 years, first in Cebu, Philippines, and now the last four years in Oahu. We feel that the "best is yet to come"!!
