I appreciated this prayer, posted on the Presbyterian Disaster Assistance Facebook page...





September 2024 Session Meetings Highlights

The Deacons are sponsoring an outreach event on October 29 addressing cyber security and elder fraud presented by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department. The annual Service of Solace will be held on December 1.

Pastor David reported that September saw the return of Bible study groups and Grief Share. The annual Church Picnic will be on October 20 at Lone Mountain Park with blessing of pets beginning at noon.

The Magnify Commission (matters relating to worship) reported that MVPC will celebrate World Communion Sunday on October 6. The Chancel Choir robes have been dry cleaned. The Commission was happy to report that several new members have volunteered as greeters. Decorating the Church for the holidays will take place on Saturday, November 30.

The Serve Commission (serving others outside of MVPC) reported that \$1,000 was sent to Presbyterian Disaster Assistance for hurricane relief efforts. The Commission is revamping the donation center in Fellowship Hall to reduce clutter. Several people from the Commission will be attending the Hoving Home gala on October 17. Plans are being made to participate with Olive Crest to provide Thanksgiving food boxes. Elder Dennis Bunce reported that the Salute to Veterans dinner will be on November 1 and will include a program honoring deceased veterans. Twelve people from MVPC visited the Caridad homeless facility in downtown Las Vegas to learn about the programs and services provided by Caridad.

The Nurture Commission (taking care of our congregation) reported that the Sunday School is learning about communion. The Youth Group is learning about the life of Christ through the television series "The Chosen." The Women's and Men's ministries are both very active. The U50 (young adults) group will continue its Bible studies with a study of the Book of Leviticus.

The Gather Commission (taking care of gathering in groups large and small) reported that for the Church Picnic on October 20 MVPC will provide the meat and asks that participants bring a dish to pass.

Stewardship Commission (being good managers of time, talents, and treasures) presented financial reports for August. Finance is reviewing the recently completed capital reserve study and is focusing on the needs over the next five years. Finance is also reviewing methods to improve investment returns over the same period. Elder Al Youmans reported that landscape irrigation leaks had been repaired and an inspection of the natural gas facilities serving the building showed no issues.

Session approved engaging the Fuller Institute's educational program on spiritual formation groups.

Elders Chris Kirschman, Dian Ward, Laura Martin, Karla Canfield and Dennis Bunce reported on the Fall Nevada Presbytery meeting held at the Reno Korean Presbyterian Church on September 10-11. All have been appointed to various committees of the Presbytery.

The next Session meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, October 23, 2024 at 7:00 p.m.


