READ Philippians 1:1-21

- What words or phrases describe Paul's relationship with his friends at the church in Philippi?
 - Why does he feel this way?
- Paul accredits the advancement of the gospel to what factors?
 - As a result of these factors, what has happened?
- Paul is imprisoned due to creating civic disorder when he cast out a demon from a girl who earned money for her master by telling fortunes (Acts 16:16-19). Does Paul hold a grudge since he is punished for healing the girl?
- What is God saying to you in these verses?
 - Are there difficult things in your life God has used to point people to His power and love?

REFLECT

- How is it possible for Paul to experience joy when he is wrongfully punished and imprisoned?
 - What attitudes and beliefs are involved in his positive countenance?
- How often do you believe the idea that "I cannot be happy unless I've got it all together"? Explain your reasoning.
- As you read Philippians 4:4, and Philippians 1:1-8, how can you find joy?
- How do you live in consistent joy?
 - What is the Holy Spirit prompting you to release into His control?
