
Scandalous Christmas The Fugitive Birth of Jesus



Another time (Jesus) went into the synagogue, and a man with a shriveled hand was there. 2 Some of them were looking for a reason to accuse Jesus, so they

watched him closely to see if he would heal him on the Sabbath. 3 Jesus said to the man with the shriveled hand, "Stand up in front of everyone." Mark 3:1-3

4 Then Jesus asked them, "Which is lawful on the Sabbath: to do good or to do evil, to save life or to kill?" But they remained silent. 5 He looked around at them in anger The word anger here is violent emotion. and, deeply distressed at their stubborn hearts, said to the man, "Stretch out your hand." He stretched it out, and his hand was completely restored. 6 Then the Pharisees went out and began to plot with the Herodians how they might kill Jesus. Mark 3:4-6

Jesus went around in Galilee, purposely staying away from Judea because the Jews there were waiting to take his life. John 7:1

The Pharisees went out and plotted how they might kill Jesus. 15 Aware of this, Jesus withdrew from that place. Matthew 12:14-15

Again they tried to seize him, but he escaped their grasp 40 Then Jesus went back across the Jordan to the place where John had been baptizing in the early days. John 10:39-40

Three habits to prioritize when you are on the run

On Herod's birthday the daughter of Herodias danced for them and pleased Herod so much 7 that he promised with an oath to give her whatever she asked. 8 Prompted by her mother, she said, "Give me here on a platter the head of John the Baptist." 9 The king was distressed, but because of his oaths and his dinner guests, he ordered that her request be granted 10 and had John beheaded in the prison. 11 His head was brought in on a platter and given to the girl, who carried

it to her mother. 12 John's disciples came and took his body and buried it. Then they went and told Jesus..

When Jesus heard what had happened, he withdrew by boat privately to a solitary place. Matthew 14:6-13
