





From the Pastor's view...Deeper into a New Year

As we approach a new year, one prayer that God has given me is that 2025 will be a year that we each find ourselves going deeper in several areas.

Certainly, first deeper in our faith as well as deeper in our knowledge of Scripture. Third, deeper in our desire to be on mission; sharing the love of Jesus to our community, state and ultimately nation/ world. And finally, deeper in our relationships with one another at Newington.

To this end, I know several of you have taken on the challenge to go deeper in both your knowledge of both Scripture and faith. And one way that some of us are engaging in this, is through the "Reading through the Gospels" challenge in one year. Five days a week for 52 weeks (which began a month ago); we are reading short passages from the Gospels and then answering two to three questions on each of those passages.

Personally, I have found this to be quite useful and meaningful for me recently.

So, as we begin this year, I thought I would share something that the Lord taught me just last week from one of our daily readings.

On Christmas Eve, the devotional was from the first eight verses of Mark. Here is a portion:

As it is written in Isaiah the prophet, "Behold, I send my messenger before your face, who will prepare your way, the voice of one crying in the wilderness:

'Prepare the way of the Lord, make his paths straight,'" John appeared, baptizing in the wilderness and proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. – Mark 1:2-4 (ESV)

So, from this passage:

Q. How is repentance related to the coming of Jesus? How is this important to our understanding of grace and salvation?

[It is fully fied in. We can't understand the impact of grace, apart from our own desire to repent.]

Q. Think about someone who has/had been "crying out in the wilderness." What was your life like prior to, then after encountering them?

[When I was in high school, it was my youth pastor. He counseled me just before I went to college, as my life was a mess. My problem was that I was living for an audience of one...ME! So, when I went to college, I was so prepared for a complete transformation because of the change and witness that I saw in Pastor Herman Heade.]

Also, this year we all will be challenged not only with going deeper in our own faith and knowledge of Scripture, but deeper in how we love those in our community.

In practical application of how we can 'cry out repentance into the wilderness,' specifically within our community; this month we have the opportunity to host the GUEST ministry at our church. I strongly encourage you to at least pray, and if able, to participate in helping those in our own 'wilderness'--folks who are less fortunate. Please see the GUEST info on the FYI board or church website to find out specific ways/days you can help.

In addition, this year we will have opportunities to participate in a mission trip, opportunities and outreaches to families with children and opportunities to serve and help those who are going through struggling times. In 2025, I hope that you will accept the challenge to go deeper!




pel of Jesus Christ—and the work continues. The Peru National Leadership Team, made up of six experienced, passionate volunteers, desires for more children to be saved and
