Longings

Greetings to you this January! As you may know, PATHWAYS is a ministry of Christ Lutheran Church in Belvidere. We are grateful for the many connections we have made over the past several years.

As I was reflecting on our direction for the future, I picked up *The Great Search* by John Philip Newell. In the introduction, the author speaks of the longings in us all. "Some of us are searching from within the four walls of our religious inheritance, and others are seeking ... beyond the bounds of tradition." He writes of the creative tension between the temple (those who attend church) and the wilderness (those not in church). There is commonality between the two; we are yearning for community and a deeper relationship with each other and the natural world.



John Philip Newell outlines the teachings of Thomas Berry, a catholic priest and theologian who identified with nature as a source of spirituality. Berry understood how to expand upon the creative tension by offering a pathway to those in the temple and the wilderness. "We can gain a sense of spirituality through the revelation of scripture and through the revelation of nature. Every life form is an expression of the Divine."

I realized that Newell's writings reflected the discussions our committee has been having as we plan for 2025!

Newell concludes his introduction with the words of Jesus:

"Seek and you will find."

This is the promise that can lead us in our searching. It is a promise filled with hope for the urgent challenges of this moment in time as we open to the quest of the Spirit within us for healing and home. In this age of division and conflict, PATHWAYS will continue to live out our mission and provide opportunities to be present to one another, our communities and the earth.

PATHWAYS, committed to Christ's call, encourages seekers of all faiths and all walks of life to deepen their relationship with humanity, creation, and the Divine.
