In 2024, FPC joined over 300 Presbyterian PC(USA) churches as an Earth Care Congregation. This past year, our Creation Care Team sponsored Sunday School classes, established a community garden providing fresh vegetables for Sherando and Highland Food Pantries, eliminated disposable dining ware in the kitchen to improve energy efficiency, and continued transitioning to LED lighting with help from a \$2,500 grant.
