History Spotlight - Ed Martin

Ed Martin's Mom Evelyn Phillips came up from Tennessee in 1944 with her parents Zack and Minda Phillips and many other siblings. His grandpa was a school teacher there and a farmer here. Ed and his brother Larry were born in Midland. Church for them met at his Uncle Frank Phillips house at first and eventually met at an old Schoolhouse like building in Mapleton that's basement flooded every spring. Ed says that a new building, the Church of Christ on M-20 was built mostly by Church members with his dad Oval Martin being a Mason who helped lay it's blocks. That Church dedication was on March 11th, 1962. Many newer members there worked for Dow and came up from Texas. They then outgrew that Church location and had our current Church building built by Booth builders with the dedication on March 16, 1986.
