Sign #3 - Jesus at the Pool: "Do you want to be healed?"

Hello MVPC!

This Sunday, in John 5:1-9, we find a deeply human moment in the life of Jesus, where he heals a man who had been crippled for 38 years, lying by the Pool of Bethesda. The scene is familiar to many of us: a large group of disabled people, all waiting for a miraculous healing at the pool's edge, believing that the water could heal them when it stirred. Among them is a man who has waited longer than most, in desperation, frustration, and perhaps even hopelessness. And then, Jesus comes.

What makes this story so compelling is not only the healing, but the interaction between Jesus and the man. Jesus does not simply heal him; he asks a question that cuts deep: *"Do you want to be healed?"* It seems like an obvious question, but when we look closer, we see that Jesus is touching on something much deeper: a question about desire, faith, and willingness to change.

This powerful encounter reminds us that healing is not just about physical restoration—it's about a spiritual renewal. Jesus' question challenges us all: Are we truly open to receiving God's healing in our lives? Are we willing to step out of our own places of brokenness and limitation to experience the fullness of life He offers?

In the coming Sunday sermon, we will dive deeper into the significance of this passage, exploring how Jesus' actions challenge us to reflect on our own struggles. We will consider what it means to wait for healing, how we can often become paralyzed in our own pain, and the invitation Jesus gives us to step into new beginnings. In addition, we'll look at the broader context of healing in the Gospel of John, understanding it as a symbol of the transformation Jesus offers to each of us.

As we gather for worship this Sunday, I invite you to reflect on your own desires for healing and change. Are there areas in your life where you have been waiting for God's intervention? Let us come together with open hearts, ready to hear God's voice calling us to wholeness and new life.

As Jesus asked the paralytic, so too He asks us, "Do you want to be healed?"

On Youtube under the video, where you can start, pause, etc. is a "cc". Click on that to start closed caption.






There will be a memorial service for Lynn Peterson on Feb. 1st at
