# 1) The first characteristic of a high-powered, difference-making person is knee-knocking, teeth-chattering fear.

#### Judges 6:11,12:

When the angel of the LORD appeared to Gideon, he said, "The LORD is with you, mighty warrior."

God sees qualities in you that you don't even see.

## 2) The second characteristic of a high-powered, difference-making person is paralyzing doubt.

"But sir," Gideon replied, "if the LORD is with us, why has all this happened to us? Where are all his wonders that our fathers told us about when they said, 'Did not the LORD bring us up out of Egypt? 'But now the LORD has abandoned us and put us into the hand of Midian." **Judges 6:13**  The LORD turned to him and said, "Go in the strength you have and save Israel out of Midian's hand. Am I not sending you?" (Judges 6:14)

## The strength you currently have is enough to do what God is calling you to do.

### 3) The Third Characteristic of a High-Powered, Difference-Making Person is Crippling Insecurity

"But Lord," Gideon asked, "how can I save Israel? My clan is the weakest in Manasseh, and I am the least in my family." The LORD answered, "I will be with you, and you will strike down all the Midianites together." Gideon replied, "If now I have found favor in your eyes, give me a sign that it is really you talking to me." Judges 6:15-17

"The fleece was not a sign of Gideon's faith. God had already called him -Gideon knew what he was supposed to do. The fleece was an expression of resistance. God responds to the fleece not as an affirmation of Gideon's faith but as a concession to Gideon's doubt." John Ortberg

Your resume and family history, however uninspiring, are enough for God to use you.

4) The Fourth Characteristic of a High-Powered, Difference-Making Person is Lack of Adequate Support

A hundred and twenty thousand swordsmen had fallen that day. Judges 8:10
