## There are three different Food Programs:

### Grocery-style shopping – Everyone Qualifies

Clients can pick up:

1 time per calendar week

**Eligibility:** All clients regardless of household income or residence

**Stations (items change daily):**

- Canned/Dry Goods
- Deli/Dairy
- Frozen Meat
- Fresh Fruit and Vegetables
- Bread and Desserts

### USDA TEFAP - The Emergency Food Assistance Program:

**Distribution:**

Typically starts 2nd week of each month - start dates posted at the pantry.

**Eligibility:**

- Residence within the Pantry region
- Based on household income
- Additional items when available

**Typical items (changes monthly):**

- 1 protein
- 1 bag of canned and dry goods
- Additional items when available

### USDA CSFP - Commodity Supplemental Food Program

**Frequency:** 1 package per month

**Distribution:**

3rd Monday of each month

**Eligibility:**

- Senior Citizens age 60+
- Based on household income
- Photo ID required to verify age

**Note:** Each senior citizen in an eligible household can receive a package

**Typical Items:** 35 pound box of food. Items change each month
