#### From the Pastor's View: HUMILITY...a Must!

I know that some of you have continued to faithfully follow the daily YEAR IN THE GOSPELS TOGETHER devotionals. It is encouraging for me to hear of your desire to grow in not only your knowledge of the Word of God. But more importantly, your hope that it changes you spiritually from the inside out.

To that end, I promised a periodic story or challenge from our study of the Gospels as we read through them together.

So here is a bonus thought for this month, about one of the daily readings for next week (specifically week 14, day 3).

Throughout the Scriptures, there is an occasional image that is used to beginning a relationship with Jesus. And that image is of a DOOR!

John wrote in the final book of Revelation,

Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me. – Revelation 3:20 (ESV)

That is pretty clear cut about how one invites to Jesus into their lives...they open the door.

Consider also some of the historic sites in either Jerusalem or the city of Jesus's birth Bethlehem. And what makes most of these sites noteworthy and memorable, is that they are not simple-looking. Today, they have been refurbished or presented to the extreme, what we may call ornate or gaudy.

But the fact is that Jesus was suggesting something completely different: humility. Jesus lived and presented himself as humble as he walked by, in or through these same areas of Jerusalem or Bethlehem.

For example, some of you may remember the doors or gates in Jerusalem, which we studied in Samuel during our Wednesday Deeper Bible studies last year. One of those doors was the 'Dung' gate. A gate that reminds us that we must be also humble as Jesus was.

As we will be reading next week in our 'Gospels together' reading,

"Enter by the narrow gate. For the gate is wide and the way is easy that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are many. For the gate is narrow and the way is hard that leads to life, and those who find it are few. - Matthew 7:13-14 (ESV)

The door or gate to Jesus is narrow. Jesus said it is hard. But why is it hard? Because we don't naturally live and ooze humility, do we? So, it begs the question...what is humility?

Humility was obviously important to Jesus throughout His life, from His birth to His death and resurrection. For us, humility comes across when someone is not proud or overly pretentious. Basically, the absence of arrogance.

Today as a church family, may we all surrender to Jesus; and allow Him to truly teach us what it means to live humbly. And let it begin when we practice the first and second great commandments: that we love God above all else, and likewise that we strive to love others above ourselves!

The boys and girls knew to guickly pick up their chairs and scoot to the side, clearing the narrow alleyway anytime a bicycle or motorbike needed to squeeze through. These interruptions to the discipleship class happened often enough that they had become normal, and the children and their teachers carried on with worship and Bible teaching once the traffic had cleared.



The tiny thoroughfare in the middle of the slum was the only space that members of Grace Baptist Church could find to hold The Greatest Journey lessons. But they were undeterred. Every Saturday morning, they ar-

rived to find the boys and girls waiting for them and eager to hear the Bible story they'd come to share.



God is using Operation Christmas Child and The Greatest Journey, our follow-up discipleship program for shoebox gift recipients, to introduce children in this slum in Illoilo, Philippines, to the Gospel. Most of their families aren't Christians, and they had never before had an opportunity to learn about God's love for them.


