## What is a Legacy Gift?

A legacy gift is a gift that withstands the test of time, and something that remains as a forever gift in the legacy of Kenova United Methodist Church.

# Where does your gift go?

All donations through the Kenova UMC Memorial Giving Tree will go to the Building Fund for the church Trustees to use at their disposal to continue to make needed updates and maintain the existing church building, which is a living legacy of KUMC.

### How does it work?

The Memorial Giving Tree will be located on the wall adjacent from the welcome desk on the first floor of the church. The tree will consist of a trunk with several branches going different directions. At the ends of each branch will be leaves.

Each leaf can be purchased for \$500. Each leaf be given in honor or in memory of someone. Each leaf will be engraved with the name/s that each donor wishes to have engraved. The names will be forever etched in the KUMC Memorial Giving Tree and be a reminder to current and future generations of those who came before and are a part of the legacy that is Kenova United Methodist Church.

### How to donate?

Leaves can be purchased and engraved for \$500 each, and you can put as many names that can fit on each leaf. In the future, we will also offer larger engraved stones that will go across the bottom of the display. The stones will be \$1,000 each, and they will have space for more names to be listed.
