Spring is the season for new beginnings! Whether you're cleaning out parts of your home or watching the flowers bloom in your garden, it's a time for new life and growth. Like a good gardener, Jesus wanted to help cultivate the seeds of faith in his friends so they could all grow closer to God. In this 4-week series, kids will learn all about the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus as he sowed the seeds of new life in the world. Kids will discover that **God sent Jesus to save us**, **Jesus understands when we're hurting**, **makes all things new**, and **connects us to God**.

Want to learn and grow alongside your kid as we go through this teaching series? You can! Spend a few minutes each week **studying** the passages of Scripture we'll be teaching, **praying** about what God wants to do in you and in your family, and **growing** by putting God's words into practice in your own life.

WEEK 1

God sent Jesus to save us.
John 12:1–8; Genesis 3:1–24

This week, kids hear about how **Jesus was anointed** with perfume by Mary.

- **BIG IDEA:** God sent Jesus to save us.
- **BIBLE:** John 12:1–8



PRAY

This week, thank God for sending Jesus to save you.



ASK THIS

Because sometimes you and your kid need a conversation-starter that isn't, "So . . . how was church?"

- **What did Mary do to show her love for Jesus?**
- **If you could be in a garden with God, like Adam and Eve were, what are the things you would want to do together?**

WEEK 2

Jesus understands when we're hurting.
Matthew 26:36–46; Isaiah 53:1–5

Sunday, April 13th



THIS WEEK

This week, kids hear about how **Jesus prayed** in the garden of **Gethsemane** before being arrested.

- **BIG IDEA:** Jesus understands when we're hurting.
- **BIBLE:** Matthew 26:36–46



PRAY

This week, thank God for being with you through your pain and suffering.



ASK THIS

Because sometimes you and your kid need a conversation-starter that isn't, "So . . . how was church?"

- **What did Jesus pray about in the garden?**
- **Is it easy to talk about how you feel when you're hurting? Who can you talk to or ask for help when you are feeling this way?**

WEEK 3

Jesus makes all things new.
Luke 24:1–12; Revelation 22:1–5

Sunday, April 20th



THIS WEEK

This week, kids hear about how **Jesus** died and **came back to life!**

- **BIG IDEA:** Jesus makes all things new.
- **BIBLE:** Luke 24:1–12



PRAY

This week, ask for help showing others the new life God offers.



ASK THIS

Because sometimes you and your kid need a conversation-starter that isn't, "So . . . how was church?"

- **Why was the tomb empty?**
- **Who can you share the story of Jesus with this week?**

WEEK 4

Jesus connects us to God.
John 20:19–31; John 15:1–13

Sunday, April 27th



THIS WEEK

This week, kids hear about how **Jesus showed his scars** to his disciples.

- **BIG IDEA:** Jesus connects us to God.
- **BIBLE:** John 20:19–31



PRAY

This week, ask for opportunities to connect others with God.



ASK THIS

Because sometimes you and your kid need a conversation-starter that isn't, "So . . . how was church?"

- **Why were all the disciples locked in a room?**
- **How can you encourage a friend who feels disconnected from God?**



BIG IDEA: God sent Jesus to save us.

BIBLE: Jesus Anointed at Bethany: John 12:1-8



BIG IDEA: Jesus understands when we're hurting.

BIBLE: Jesus Prays in Gethsemane: Matthew 26:36-46

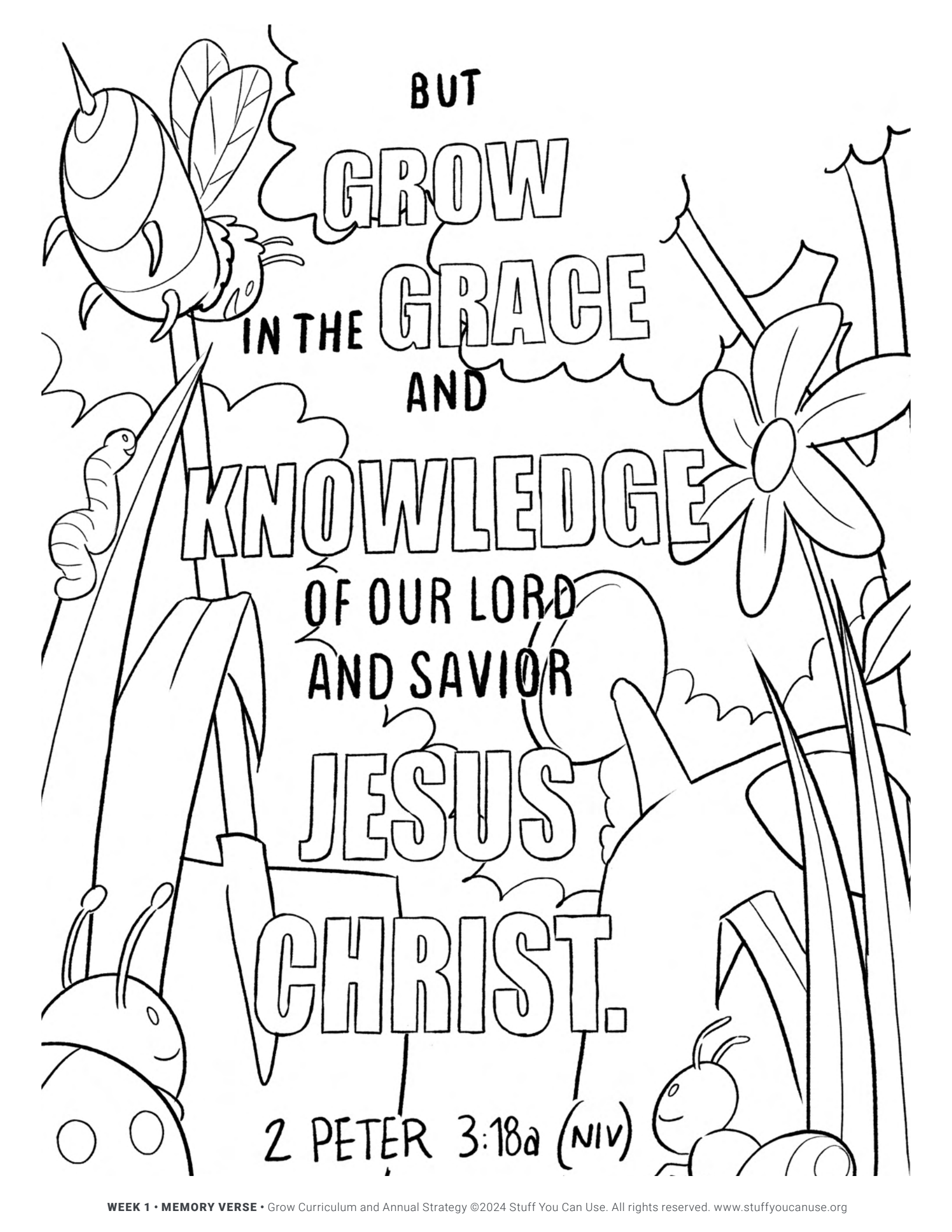


BIG IDEA: Jesus makes all things new.
