April 14 - 19/ Day 1: Read Matthew 10:16-42:

Jesus is preparing His followers for the responses they will receive in His name.

- Q. How can we be as "wise as serpents and harmless as doves" as we live in this world?
- Q. How are we to respond to the challenges faced?

April 14 - 19/ Day 2: Read Matthew 14:1-12:

- Q. What do you feel is driving Herod's actions in this story? What about John's actions?
- Q. How have you let fear or distress overwhelm your understanding of right and wrong? How? Why?
- April 14 19/ Day 3: Read Mark 6:14-29; Luke 9:7-9: Mark's account of John's beheading shows Herod as a man in conflict. He likes John but will not accept his message. Also, he was afraid of John, but he protected him.
- Q. What life-lessons do you see in the story of John the Baptist's death?
- Q. What conflicts between action and belief do you see in your own life story and history?
- Q. How can you avoid falling into the type of trap that Herod finds himself in?

April 14 - 19/ Day 4: Read Matthew 14:13-21; Mark 6:30-44:

- Q. When is a time when you felt a nudging or command from God to do something and didn't feel up to the task?
- Q. How do these passages challenge in using time, money, talents, relationships, etc that we have been given?
- <u>April 14 19/ Day 5: Read Luke 9:10-17; John 6:1-15:</u> As you think about your life and what God is calling you to do, remember that Jesus is big enough to see you though the impossible situations in your life.
- Q. What passages/promises help you remember that Jesus is sufficient to provide for all your needs?
- Q. What acts of personal ministry are you currently involved in? Why do you participate in them?
- <u>April 14 19/ Day 6: Study and Meditation Consider the following questions:</u> This week, we saw that Jesus calls us as His servant followers to a life of commitment, even in the face of rejection or persecution.
- Q. Which fears or challenge in this calling from Jesus, do you struggle with the most? Why?
- Q. What can you do to keep going in the face of any rejection to reach out to others in Jesus's name?
