THE GOOD NEWS

I am about to do a new thing; now it springs forth; do you not perceive it? - Isaiah 43:19a

We have crossed the midpoint of our Lenten fasts, and are heading toward Jerusalem and toward Easter. These days of self-examination, prayer, and almsgiving—the hallmarks of Lent—are perhaps giving way to new insights, new connections, and new joys. How have you grown in these weeks? What leaves have sprouted? What bud has bloomed? What fruit has ripened?

It feels appropriate that April is National Poetry Month; there is something quite poetic about the changing of seasons, both in our environment and in the liturgy. Are you familiar with the form of poetry called haiku? It is a short-form poem that originates in Japan. The rules are simple: three lines, each with a specific number of syllables, 5-7-5. Haiku are traditionally written about the natural world, but English-language poets routinely take liberties with the subject matter and write haiku about all sorts of things.

At last month's council retreat, I took such liberties. As your council members wondered about what God could be calling us to be, here in our community, at this time, I asked them to write haiku about how they want it to feel in our neighborhood, and how they see us reaching our goals. Here is some of that poetry:

sunny San Marcos brings light to our life always blessed children of God

our neighbors are friends some we have met and some not community thrives

beacon of God's love meet our new neighbors and friends always a safe place meeting face to face we encounter each other what can God do here?

God in the details breezes, clouds, rocks, dog walkers feel all you notice

we all share our space young and old and in between building ministry

Not only are these reflections a beautiful example of who we see SMLC becoming, but I deeply appreciated everyone's willingness to try something new. It can be intimidating to express your thoughts and feelings in a new format—or to express them at all. Maybe you have never written a poem in your life. Maybe you love poetry! Maybe the last time you thought about poetry was in high school English class. Now is always a great time to try something new. Perhaps give haiku a try. If you write one (or more!) I would be delighted to read it.

As this year unfolds, we will continue to build our ministry together. The council has set goals for reaching out into our community, and making ourselves known to our neighbors. We are going to try new things. We are going to invite new people and make new connections. Every person who calls SMLC home in any way—whether you've been a member for decades, or are part of a group that meets here during the week, or are newly joining us for worship online—is part of the work God is doing here in our neighborhood. Together, we can trust that God is calling us to broader and deeper relationships. Together, we can step out of our comfort zones into the world God loves.




