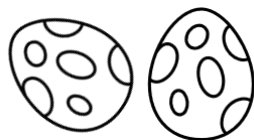

History Spotlight—A Spring Bulletin in 1987 and 1997

Looking back, our teaching Ministers were Paul Jackson in 1987 and Jim Chilton in 1997. In a 1987 bulletin, Jim Karl (Sr.) was listed as spending two weeks in Panama with the Panama-Costa Rica Medical Mission team and Cathy Karl and her teammates had won 2nd place at the nationals of the precision skating competition in Tulsa Oklahoma. It was the last week to give to the Shults-Lewis commodity program that collected fruit juice that year, but it couldn't be Hi-C. Kathy Conklin (Kay) and Larry and Sharilyn Herren were Greeters (the Herren's later went on to become house parents at Schults Lewis). Also planned was a canoe trip by Al Henry. In a 1997 bulletin, there was a summer golf league being planned for Sunday afternoons, an Easter Egg hunt at a member's home, and upcoming plans for member bridal shower and Weddings in May. Also, Secret Sisters had combined with another Ladies Bible study to become Bible Sisters with a listing to - "direct your positive comments" to the two ladies listed in charge. The end of the Vision statement in 1997 was: ... "Each Christian is pursuing the growth and unity of the church by demonstrating loving concern and patience for each member." Eph. 4:11-16 is referenced.
