May Family Meal: The Family Meal for May is on May 14th.

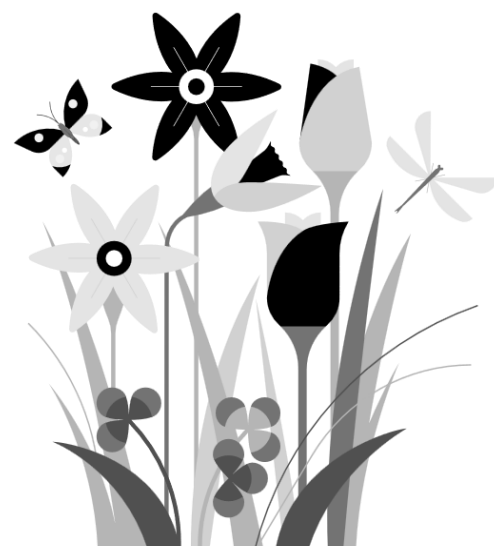

Elder Spotlight - Loran Brown

The "hard question" for April challenges us to examine our God-centeredness against our own self-centeredness. Do we conform to Jesus, or do we re-imagine "Jesus" into our own image? I believe that at the heart of this question is our call to repentance. This call to Biblical repentance calls our actions into line with our belief and our confession that "Jesus is Lord." Conformance to Jesus requires that we keep seeking honesty within ourselves. This honesty is a growth process, becoming more nuanced as we mature.

Psalms 32 gives us a view of this self-examination: "Blessed is the man whose sin the LORD does not count against him and in whose spirit is no deceit." Psalm 32 goes on to describe how this honesty of spirit drew the psalmist to admitting his sin and to repentance. Repentance requires changes in ourselves. It takes real honesty of spirit to move away from a "Jesus" re-imagined into our own image, toward the Christ Jesus who "is the same yesterday and today and forever."
