Warmup: As a kid, who was your favorite superhero?

Sermon Point 1: A Great Superhero Has Amazing Powers READ Matthew 8:6-13

- What does the centurion ask Jesus to do?
- How does the centurion's faith in Jesus highlight the connection between faith and authority?
 - O What authority does the centurion practice in his daily profession?
- What is unusual in Jesus' response to the centurion?
 - O How does this passage challenge or deepen your understanding of faith?

Sermon Point 2: A Great Superhero Overcomes Incredible Odds READ Luke 24:1-8

- Why do you think the women were the first to discover the empty tomb?
- What did the angels tell the women to do? Why did the disciples not believe the women?
- After reading these passages, in what area of your life does Jesus want you to trust His divine power?
 - O Why is this difficult?

RESPOND

- How can you partner with Jesus in relying upon Him in this hard-to-trust area of life?
- One way to trust Jesus for the miracle is like Pastor Jack said, "sing a new song." Read parts of Psalm 96; what new song can you begin singing right now?
- Choose a friend in your Life Group to be your accountability partner in encouraging you to sing this new song throughout the week. Pray with one another for the new thing Jesus will do.
