Our Mission

Thanks to the generosity of Mr. Ara Barsamian, St. Sarkis Armenian Apostolic Church has created a new scholarship program! Our mission is promoting scholastic excellence within our community. To achieve this end, we seek to assist our youth in obtaining the education they desire and deserve, as well as preparing the next generation of our church's leaders.

One scholarship of \$500.00 each will be awarded to the selected applicant. Applications will be evaluated on academic achievements, financial needs and engagement/service to St. Sarkis Church as well as to the Armenian and non-Armenian communities.

Applicant Eligibility and Criteria

- Must be 17 to 25 years of age and of Armenian descent.
- Must be currently matriculated in, or accepted to, an undergraduate program at an accredited US college/university.
- Applicant and/or parent must be a member of St. Sarkis church as of May 21, 2025.
- Must complete and provide the Application Form on the last 2 pages of this document.
- Must provide an official high school or college academic transcript.
- Must have a minimum GPA of 2.0.
- Must submit a short essay (500-1000 words) reflecting on your education, career goals and challenges you may have overcome and connection with your Armenian heritage and faith.

All applications must be submitted (postmarked) in full by <u>May 21st, 2025</u>. The award decision will be announced by June 4, 2025. Awardees will be invited to participate in our <u>Sunday, June 8,</u> <u>2025</u> Celebration of Graduates event to receive their award.

Awardee and parents (if under 18) must consent to having their photo taken as well as to a press release.

Award funds must be used toward tuition and/or books. The award may be provided to the individual or directly to the school. If to the school, please provide the school's Bursar's office contact information.

A four-member Scholarship Committee of St. Sarkis Church will review all applications and announce the award decision. Should a relative of awardee be on said committee, he/she will recuse himself/herself from the review and an alternate will be placed in his or her stead. The Scholarship Committee will clearly document the evaluation and judging process and present it to the Board of Trustees of St Sarkis Church. All decisions of the Board are final.

Scholarship applications will be evaluated based upon the following criteria: academic performance, financial need, extracurricular activities, and personal statement, with a priority given to youth who are active and members within the St. Sarkis Church.
