May 5-10/ Day 1: Read Matthew 15:21-28:

- Q. What is unusual about Jesus's interaction with this woman? Why does Jesus answer her request?
- Q. What does this passage teach us about faith?

May 5-10/ Day 2: Read Matthew 15:29-31; Mark 7:31-37:

- Q. Why do you think Jesus took the man away from the crowd? Why did he heal the man in this particular way?
- Q. Why did Jesus tell them to not tell anyone what He had done? How did they respond?

May 5-10/ Day 3: Read Matthew 15:32-39; Mark 8:1-9:

- Q. How does this feeding compare and contrast with the previous one in Mark 6:30-44?
- Q. How do you explain the disciples' lack of insight/ faith?

May 5-10/ Day 4: Read Matthew 16:1-4; Mark 8:10-12:

- Q. Why do the religious leaders ask for a sign from heaven? What do you think they were hoping to see?
- Q. Why does Jesus respond to them the way he does? How does he view them?

May 5-10/ Day 5: Read Matthew 16:5-12; Mark 8:13-16:

- Q. Why are the disciples often so slow to understand Jesus? Why are we the same way?
- Q. What was Jesus's point in the series of questions he asked them?
- Q. What religious teaching do we need to be on guard against?

May 5-10/ Day 6: Study and Meditation – Consider the following questions: This week we have read of the people's responses to Jesus & how He responded to their faith, where He wants us to trust in Him.

- Q. What is Jesus asking you to trust Him with right now? Q. What holds you back from trusting Him?
- Q. What things may you need to surrender to His lordship in your life?
- Q. Are their areas of your life (finances, time, relationships, etc.) where it is harder for you to trust God? Why?
