## Minister Spotlight — Adam Davis

"Protecting your peace" is a phrase we hear often—and there's something comforting about it. But sometimes, in our desire to guard ourselves from stress or hurt, we slip into a pattern of avoiding the very things that grow us: meaningful work, honest relationships, and the ordinary struggles of life. That isn't peace—it's something much more fragile.

Some of what gets labeled as self-care today seems to lean in that direction. But real self-care isn't indulgence—it's formation. It's choosing rest and nourishment, yes—but also doing the slow, sacred work of healing: therapy, prayer, repentance, reflection. It's learning to face what we'd rather avoid.

True peace begins with identity—knowing we are deeply, unshakably loved by God. When that love takes root, it steadies us. Because peace isn't found in hiding. It's found in being held.
