Warmup: As a child, what was that extra something you cherished most?

READ John 10:7-11, Psalm 27:1-14, Proverbs 8:34-35

- In this season of my life, I could use more _____.
- Verse 10 states, "The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life and have it to the full." What does it mean to have life "to the full"?
- How does the idea of Jesus as the Good Shepherd challenge our understanding of security and abundance in life?

Read: Psalm 27:1-14

- In this passage what things and situations could disturb our understanding of the abundant life, or life to the full?
- How is David going to experience "the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living"? How do these practices relate "having more" today?
- Now in smaller groups unpack personal experiences of "waiting on the Lord" and how the wait can be a catalyst to "life to the full".

Proverbs 8:32-34 (read in Amplified version)

- According to this passage how does one experience the blessings of God's favor and blessing?
- What does watching daily at the gates and waiting at the doorposts look like for you?

RESPOND

- What is currently distracting you for the abundant life, or "life to the full"?
- How can pressing into the spiritual habits of these Scriptures begin to flip your script and create life to the full in areas that currently seem dry?
