In summary of the seven feasts:

The first four were s_____ feasts... (v. 5-22)

- ...which focused on Jesus coming as Messiah.
- ...which described His death, burial and resurrection, as well as the coming of the Holy Spirit.

The last three were f_____ feasts... (v. 23-43)

- ...which focused on Jesus's second coming in the future.
- ...which also described Jesus's victory over sin and Satan.
- ...described the beginning of His kingdom for 1,000 years; eternal new heaven and new earth.



God's Feasts

Leviticus 23

Feast	Date	Meaning
1. Passover	March/April	Redemption/Sacrifice/Death of Messiah
2. Unleavened Bread	March/April	Sanctification/Burial of Messiah/No decay
3. Firstfruits	March/April	Represents the Savior as first of the harvest
4. Pentecost	May/June	Pentecost/Holy Spirit sent by YHWH
5. Rosh HaShanah	September/October	New Year Messiah returns to Israel ("Rapture")
6. Yom Kippur	September/October	Day of Atonement/Messiah saves Israel
7. Tabernacles	September/October	Wedding Feast/Golden Age/Messiah starts Millennium
