"Blessed Are the Doubters"

Most people know him as Doubting Thomas. The disciple who just couldn't believe unless he saw it for himself.

Poor guy. One honest moment and he gets branded for eternity.

But what if Thomas wasn't the failure we've made him out to be? What if he's the prototype of authentic faith?

This week in our series Encounters After the Empty Tomb, we journey with Thomas—one of the most beautifully human figures in the resurrection story. When Jesus first appears to the disciples, Thomas isn't there. He missed the moment. And when the others tell him, "We've seen the Lord!" he replies, "Unless I see the nail marks... I will not believe."

Sound harsh? Or does it sound like you and me on our hardest days?

The good news is this: Jesus doesn't scold Thomas. He doesn't roll His eyes. He shows up. Specifically, for him.

Dale Bruner reminds us, "Jesus doesn't confront doubt with dogma. He confronts it with scars."

And Max Lucado writes, "God doesn't dismiss your doubt. He welcomes your honesty and gives you His presence."

Eight days later, Jesus walks through a locked door and offers Thomas exactly what he asked for:

"Put your finger here... see my hands... stop doubting and believe."

What happens next is stunning. The doubter becomes the declarer. Thomas confesses: "My Lord and my God!"

It's the highest Christological statement in the entire Gospel.

Jesus ends the encounter with a blessing not just for Thomas—but for us: "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."

That's you. That's me. That's all of us who hold belief and doubt in the same hand.

This Sunday, bring your faith. Bring your questions. Bring your doubt.

Jesus isn't afraid of it. He'll walk through walls to meet you.

See you Sunday! Laugh often and Fear not! David!

April 2025 Ression Meetings Highlights

The Deacons reported that "Meet Your Deacon" Sunday on April 13 was a great success with an excellent turnout of members. The Deacons are sponsoring a safety seminar with the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police on May 1.

Pastor David reported that Holy Week services were well attended and Easter Sunday saw 625 attendees at the three services. Beginning May 11, Grace Presbyterian Church will use MVPC's facilities for worship on Sunday afternoons from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. for worship, Sunday school and fellowship. We are awaiting engineering bids for the proposed children's play area. Anderson Academy received notice that MVPC will not be renewing its use agreement after June 2025. Pastor David will be traveling to London the week of April 28 to meet up with his son, Joshua, who completed his freshman year at Florida State University's campus in Valencia, Spain.

The Magnify Commission (matters relating to worship) reported that gifts will be presented to women at worship services on Mother's Day, May 11.

The Serve Commission (serving others outside of MVPC) reported that the Pet Ministry will have a presence at the Spring Fling on May 4. The Hoving Home choir will be at MVPC for services on Sunday, April 27 and a lunch will be served to the ladies after the second service. The Commission is working on its 2025-2026 budget to present to the Finance Committee.

The Nurture Commission (taking care of our congregation) reported that the Sunday School classes will be focusing on the foundation of our faith during the month of May. The Commission is working with Grace Presbyterian Church on joint youth activities. The "Spring Fling" carnival is on May 4 with barbecue, desserts, a bounce house, carnival games and a dunk tank. Men's and Women's ministries and Bible studies are both very active.

The Gather Commission (taking care of gathering in groups large and small) noted that the next 5th Sunday brunch will be Sunday, June 29.

Stewardship Commission (being good managers of time, talents, and treasures). The Finance Committee has begun working on the 2025-2026 fiscal year budget. Elder Al Youmans reported on inspections to improve the exterior lighting at the front of the building facing the corner of Del Webb Boulevard and Sungold Drive and in the parking lot area.
