Elder Spotlight - Lee Dresden

Our question of the month for May corresponds to part of our mission statement of "Pursuing Godly Character".

Forgiveness is of major importance. Jesus, taught us this in the Lord's Prayer. We receive forgiveness and give forgiveness ... Matthew 6:12 "Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors".

We stand forgiven of our sins before God through the grace of Jesus Christ. Since we stand forgiven before God because of what Jesus Christ did, it would be wrong for us to withhold forgiveness from others. Think of the parable of the "Unmerciful Servant" in Matthew 18. Christ himself was the true example of forgiveness and gave us an example of it in this parable.

Joseph was another example of personifying forgiveness. He was originally intended to be left for dead, but then he was sold into slavery. Further injustice was done to him when he was framed by Potiphar's wife, put in prison because of it and then forgotten about by the cupbearer after helping him. How would you have responded to such hardship and mistreatment? Joseph allowed God to work in his life to change & mold his attitude towards his very negative life experiences.

Let us show our readiness to forgive, like Joseph, to reflect God's mercy.
