Worship and Faith Formation

At a time when the world is looking for meaning and purpose, the Cathedral Church of All Saints will look to fill a void. This will include deliberate and sustained efforts to connect with new audiences, a renewal of worship and a commitment to creating lasting worship experiences online.

- Continuing to expand Sunday school capacity.
- Engaging with younger and more diverse audiences.

Outreach and Engagement

Outreach is at the heart of Christian service and is deeply woven into the fabric of the Cathedral. We will aim to increase our ability to do God's work in the service of others.

- The Cathedral will expand its outreach activities.
- The Cathedral will invite other members of the community to support outreach activities.
- The Cathedral will seek to broaden its members' engagement with outreach activities, drawing especially upon younger people's passion for justice and change.
- The Cathedral will seek to collaborate even more with agencies and faith communities in the city.
- The Cathedral will renew efforts to keep its doors open to the community.

Building for the Future

The Cathedral will require additional capacity and skills to begin to realize our mission and vision.

The Cathedral will overhaul its online presence, including:

- A refreshed website completed during the fall of 2021.
- A revitalized social media presence.

Improved production quality for online services.

The Cathedral will undertake a campaign to raise the profile of the Cathedral in the community,

- To increase people participating in outreach activities and
- To raise funds to support the ongoing activities of the Cathedral.

It is from this last direction that more of our missional objectives can be supported, by

- supporting additional staffing to provide worship leadership and pastoral care,
- · restoring our building, and
- putting our music programme on a firm financial footing.

As we listen and engage, we will work to adopt an equity and inclusion lens as well as strengthen hospitality and welcome. We will work at this by:

- Strengthening the awareness of and ability to incorporate difference in the Cathedral Church community.
- Collectively addressing systemic barriers and inequities.
- Listening to the wider community to understand the perceptions of the Cathedral Church and learn what our neighbours may be seeking or hoping for from us.
- Striving to create a place of real belonging that is relevant to and representative
 of the community that surrounds the Cathedral Church and its current worshiping
 community.
- Creating an energizing and innovative place to worship that is open to all.

- Creating a welcoming space in our worship services.
